Each food establishments must have a person with an approved Manager Certification (R392-101). **Food Manager Certification is valid for only 3 years in the State of Utah** (R392-101-4). Please attach a copy of the current Food Managers Certificate to this application if one is not already on file at the Health Department.

The Southeastern Utah District Health Department requires that **all** persons employed in food service have a current food handler’s permit issued in the State of Utah, except those already certified as a Food Safety Manager.

The Food Service Sanitation Rule requires all food service establishments to be inspected by the health department.
