Guidance for Onsite-Wastewater systems permitting in Southeast Utah Health Department Jurisdiction

- 1) The client will obtain a contractor who is an active Onsite Wastewater Professional registered with DEQ and found on the associated list of certified professionals. This person is hired to complete the soil analysis and must have at least a level 1 certification. Along with hiring the wastewater professional, the client will also send the Southeast Utah Health Department (SEUHD) a completed onsite wastewater application.
- 2) The health department will meet the contractor at the client's property and confirm the soil analysis/percolation test results the licensed onsite professional presents. If a percolation test is performed, a soil analysis must also be performed. The lowest application rate of the two shall be used to design the system.
- 3) A contractor with at least a level 2 certification, will create a design for the client's property and they will submit the design to the health department for plan review. Upon approval from the SEUHD the system can be installed.
***The Onsite Wastewater Professional who completed the soil analysis phase can also complete the design if they have level two certification. There is no need to hire two different contractors unless the client wants to do so.
- 4) Once the system is installed, but not covered, the health department will complete a final inspection. The septic tank and distribution box must be filled 24 hrs prior to the final inspection. Fees must be paid before scheduling the final inspection.
- 5) The client should inform the contractor to contact the SEUHD to schedule a final inspection prior to burial. Please ensure the contractor keeps the health department informed throughout the entire process.

FEE(s):

The cost of the SEUHD's work is \$468. This fee covers the plan review process and two site visits. Any additional site visits may incur a \$79 inspection fee and mileage. Fees are subject to change.

Independent contractors will assess their own fees for soil analysis, design, and installation. Paying SEUHD is not equivalent to paying contractors and vice versa.
